Make sure you familiarise yourselves with the tack sheets and the rules for your chosen disciplines to avoid stress on show day.

- Team SJ

Teams of 4 for Alice Mernagh Cup Under 12, Robbie Bailey over 12 under 14, and John Leddingham for Seniors. Coached by Bill Maguire. Training will commence after Easter outdoors in Joe Arthurs either Friday evenings or Saturday mornings.

- Individual SJ

Dates of qualifiers for our region are not announced yet. Starts at 90cm. See <http://irishponyclub.ie/show-jumping-classic-qualifier-dates/>

- Combined training

Is an individual competition consisting of Dressage and Show Jumping. Juniors (over 12) and up need to qualify to go to the Nationals but U10 and U12 can go straight

- Pure dressage

For team and Individual competition, same criteria as combined training.

- Training and team selection

Training will take place most weeks after Easter, mainly in Joe Arthurs in Tralee or other outdoor venues with one instructor in charge of each discipline acting as a chef d'équipe. The selection process will be decided at the next committee meeting. We are a small branch and we will probably struggle to field many teams. However, team selection is often when things get contentious! The process will be stated well in advance for clarity and will be based on several criteria such as eligibility of pony/horse and rider, results in competition, commitment to the qualifiers and possibly the Nationals (and the travelling that this entails), also, a very important thing to note is that attendance at the training sessions is vital !
