

Rules for the Irish Pony Club Area 5 Jumps Ahead Competition 2017.

Horses /Ponies

Any height - Registered or Unregistered with SJI

Must not have completed in top classes such as RDS qualifiers in current or previous year

But may have competed in an ABC Class

(Therefore old grade A's who are now **regularly Pony Clubbed** are allowed)

RIDERS

Riders must be current members of a branch and have attended 3 branch rallies in 2016 to be allowed to compete in the final. The DC of each branch/Centre proprietor will be asked to confirm the eligibility of their qualified members prior to the final.

COMPETITION HEIGHTS

Height of fences in qualifiers 60cm, 75cm, 90cm, 1Meter (4 classes) Height of fences may rise 5cm for final.

A Joker Fence will be included in all classes.

A Joker fence is an optional fence in all classes.

If joker is attempted and cleared 5 seconds taken from actual time. If Joker is attempted and failed 5 seconds added to actual time.

CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITONS

3 Qualifying competitions to be held at Area 5 Venues.

Qualifiers are 2 phase- jumps 1-14+ joker. – jumps 1-8 are not timed – but jumps 1-8 must be clear – timer starts from a Point between jump 8 and 9. Jump 15 is the joker fence. Qualifiers will run nder Art 274(2 phase

Final run under Article 238 2.2 (2nd round class, both rounds timed, 2nd round against the clock))

Entry Fee at Qualifiers and Finals: €15.00

Top 10 from each qualifier will qualify for Final. Combination must compete in two qualifying competitions (but need only qualify at one) If a combination is already qualified from a previous qualifier, the qualifying place moves down the placing.

To gain qualifying place competitors must complete the first PHASE. (Falls, Eliminations etc. cannot qualify).

a combination can Qualify in two competitions but the competitions must be consecutive ie can qualify in 60cm and 75cm but can't qualify in both 60cm and 90cm. Competitors can compete again on a different pony/horse

League

There will also be a prize for the combination with the most league points at The end of the league (League points down to 10 places at each qualifier)

Final held at Cork Summer Show Sat 8th July, 11.00am start Judged under SJI show jumping rules: 238 2.2.
